Minutes of November 21, 2006 Meeting

The November 21, 2006 meeting of the RC Propbusters was called to order at 8:00 PM with 23 members present. The minutes of the September meeting were read by Bernie Liskov and accepted as read. The treasurers' monthly report was read by Ron Czikowsky and is as follows: The beginning balance was \$7798.03. Income was \$390.00. Expenses were \$180.00 which left a balance of \$8008.03. The report was accepted as read.

Committees

John Banks came up with a date of June 16, 17 for the IMAC competition. As we voted to give John the go ahead for the event he will get the IMAC people to apply for the sanction. Concerning the Bob Beringer event Bernie attended the IMAA chapter 392 meeting on Sunday 11/18/06 where he offered the idea of having a joint IMAA Propbuster event and gives ½ the landing fees to IMAA attendees. Joan Liska was gracious in declining as she felt that only IMAA members at an IMAA event could fly. She did however promise that Chapter 392 would advertise and help to get IMAA members to attend this event. She also asked if we could offer a weekend for a 2 day event sometime next summer. We will have to discuss that at the next meeting. There are no updates on the Henry Struck and Neighborhood events, but Dennis did say that he will donate an ARF to be given away during the Neighborhood event. He will be asking for the club to pay for a radio package to go into this plane. He also plans on having some building classes where this plane will be put together after some meetings to teach newer members what some of the proper building techniques are.

Dennis also told us that January 8 is the date of an electric fly-in at the Mohegan Sun Arena starting at 5:00 PM. As this is the first time we will be flying there will be a limit to the number of flyers allowed with the first dibs to those who helped fly the blimp during the past basketball season and we must demonstrate to the management that we can fly safely. Anyone interested in attending should contact Dennis at 860-376-6230.

Old Business:

Dennis, Jack Tom and Bernie met with Stu Gadbois about our being able to utilize the area behind the trees as a helicopter flying area. Stu did not have a problem with that and agreed to it but he is going to raise the rent to \$2,000.00. He will give us a lease holding that rent to not increase for the next 5 years. Stu will help in removing the stumps to a different area of the property. Dennis asked Tom and Jack to mark the smaller trees which will be removed by the Cub Scouts in an effort to open up the buffer area between the 2 flight lines.

Dennis suggested that we use the following dates for next year.

Club fun-Fly	early in 2007
IMAC event	June 16 and 17
Beringer Event	June 23 and 24
Henry Struck electric fly-in	July 21 and 22
Neighborhood Fun-Fly	August 12
Heli Fly-In	August 25 and 26
AMA event	September 2007 (pending AMA approval)

Bernie asked for Fred that the Beringer date be moved into July. That will be brought up for discussion at the December meeting. It would have to be the week before or the week after the Henry Struck event.

2 Votes were taken on the following proposed rules changes. First it was voted that anyone paying their dues on Sept 1 thru Dec 31 will be given their membership for the next calendar year as long as they also have an AMA membership renewed for the next year as well. The second vote was to add the office of assistant Recording Secretary to help with the duties of the Recording Secretary. That also passed. Fred and Rich will make the appropriate changes in the bylaws.

New Business:

Dennis again spoke about wanting to provide a better flying surface for the many electric planes we now have flying at the field. He asked any interested members to try to gather information on different methods of making an approximately 20 foot by 50 foot smooth area.

Dennis also reminded everyone that any dogs that are at the field must be on a leash at all times. This is a safety concern.

Dennis also spoke about new ways of solving the problem of non uniform methods of placing frequency tags on the frequency board. He made the suggestion that we use the same type of membership cards we have now but add the frequency numbers to them and provide a different type of clamp which will hold them sideways on the frequency board. Suggestions are welcome.

Dennis proposed that we have a 2 hour News Year day fly-in on Jan. 1 with a pot luck meal. Anyone who is interested, please contact Dennis.

A motion was made for Dennis to buy himself a new laminating machine as he really doesn't have use of the one he lent to Bernie for making membership cards. That motion passed.

Nominations for club Officers

President: Dennis was nominated for President. He has accepted the nomination.

Vice president: Bill Mares and Ray Knieriem were both nominated and have accepted the nominations

Recording Secretary: Bernie Liskov was nominated and has accepted the nomination.

Field Marshall: Jack Holmgren was nominated and has accepted the nomination.

Safety Officer: Tom Vernon was nominated and has accepted the nomination.

Newsletter Editor: Fred Meyer was nominated and accepted the nomination.

Board of Directors: Charlie Bacon, Carl Barker and George White were nominated and accepted the nominations.

Assistant Recording Secretary: Peter Sylvester was nominated

Nominations were offered again but none were made for the other officers. Elections will be held in December.
