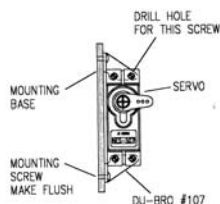

TIP OF THE MONTH

Servo Mounting

If you need to mount a servo sideways, cut a 1/8" piece of ply 1" X 2-1/2", center 2 short control horns so the holes in the horns are same distance apart as the mounting holes on the servo. Cut the horn mounting screws off flush with the plywood mount & treat these holes with thin CA. The holes in the control horns are spaced to the approximate width for mounting the servo. No additional holes are required.
