Charlie was not doing well physically during his last 5 years so he was not flying often nor at the field often, but he was an avid modeler and devoted to our hobby. On a personal note, I met Charlie in 1942 when I first joined the club. He was mentor, a very good friend, and he gave me my first opportunity to fly a modern radio control model that got me back into this hobby after a 20 year absence.

Elliot Norman, 77, long time member, who I believe inspired this Son Phil, and Brother Fred to get into and enjoy our great hobby. Even during his final months Elliot would come to the field with Phil & Fred every week and maybe fly a bit, but surely sit and watch with enjoyment even when he was on full time oxygen. I am very happy to say I did have the opportunity to sit and chat with Elliot at the field from time to time and he was always gracious, supportive of his passion and a true gentleman.

John Holmgren, 71, another staunch supporter of our club who was always pushing us to improve our field, our club and our building skills. Jack was the guy who made sure the benches were coated, the machinery was operating properly, the mower blades were sharpened, the field was cut & trimmed, and he constantly bugged our esteemed treasurer we needed to spend more money. On a personal note, I met Jack in 1949 when we formed the Balsa Bugs control line club. We travelled all over the Northeast competing in Control Line Stunt events & one or both of us would usually come home with a trophy. Great guy, terrific values & he along with Charles & Elliot will be missed.

Due to the lower cost of the fence. The club purchased an Easy-Up tent to use for the cooking area.
