MODEL OF THE MONTH

Bill Mares brought in a couple of quads he got for Christmas. Both of these quads come with transmitters and chargers ready to fly. The first one on the left is X-25-1 that looks like a flying car. This model will do flips in four directions by simply pushing a button on the transmitter and moving the right stick (ELE/AIL) in any direction. Cost \$44.00. The Millennium Falcon is a great indoor quad. It is made of foam and the props are well contained within the model. The model seems very stable and easy to fly. Cost \$100.00.





Mark O'Connell brought in a 1954 Piper Tri-Pacer originally built by Bruce Oatway & he donated it to whoever wanted it. Dave Hoffman took it and we cannot wait to see it fly. The model is heavy but it should fly OK. Way to go Mark, if you've never flown it and do not plan to, give it to someone who will give it a try.



Fred Meyer Brought in his repaired 3D Hobby Shop Slick 42 that he crashed at Dodd Stadium last Sept. All of the basket of small pieces were put back together like a puzzle and once assembled they provided the patterns to cut out new bulkheads and fuselage sides. It was flown on January 28th and seemed to fly pretty much as it did prior to the crash. It was an interesting project and one that I would do again to save a plane I liked.
